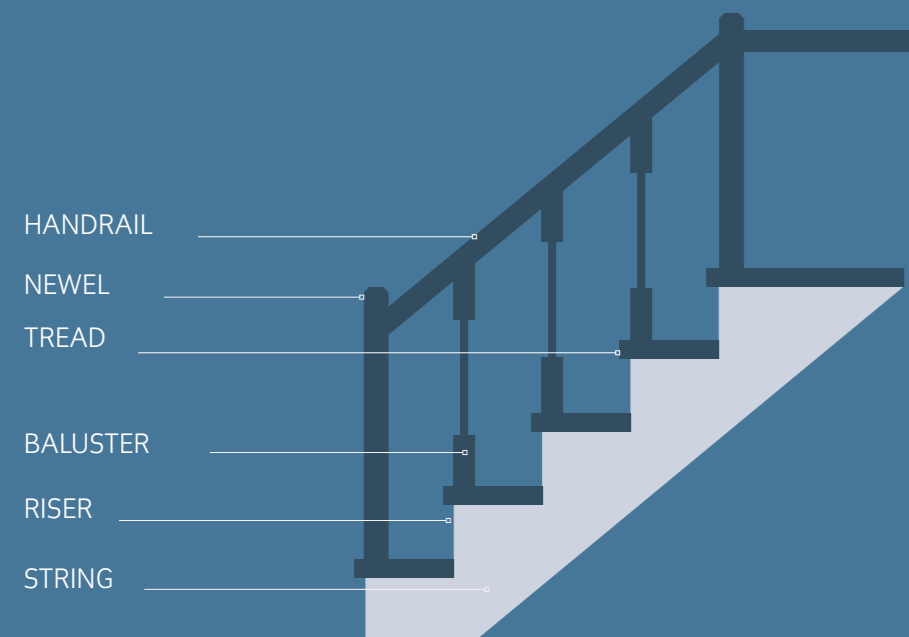

1. Pine (*Pinus sylvestris*)

Now the most commonly used timber for stairs due to its inherent strength and cost benefits. The International Timber offer is a Scandinavian joinery grade redwood.

2. New Zealand Clear Pine (*Pinus radiata*)

A new product for the staircase sector, available as square dressed boards manufactured using the best pruned logs, free of knots and renowned for the finest grade and machine finish.

3. Oak (*Quercus petraea/robur*) (*Quercus alba*)

A beautiful classic hardwood timber, Oak is strong and durable and an extremely popular choice for staircases.

4. Sapele (*Entandrophragma cylindricum*)

Sapele is an incredibly strong and durable hardwood with an attractive reddish brown finish, often chosen when a slightly darker end product is required.

5. American Walnut (*Juglans nigra*)

Varying in colour from a light brown through to deep chocolate and a purple hue, American Walnut provides an elegant decorative finish with grain patterns ranging from smooth to strongly figured.

6. Tulip (*Liriodendron tulipifera*)

Strong for its weight, Tulipwood ranges in colour from pale brown ecru to a deeper green hue, with a medium to fine texture and attractive straight grain.

7. Ash (*Fraxinus* spp.)

An extremely strong and durable timber, Ash is often chosen where a lighter coloured finish is required. Ash demonstrates a very pronounced grain throughout and is often specified as a more cost effective substitute for oak.

CASE STUDY EDWARDS & HAMPSON LTD



International Timber supplies American Black Walnut timber to Edwards & Hampson Joinery

Raw American Black Walnut timber was supplied to Edwards & Hampson (EH) Joinery by International Timber to assist in building a staircase for a residential client.

The project involved designing, manufacturing and installing a bespoke, double curved staircase in the client's home, with features including a curved string, handrail and treads.

American Black Walnut timber was used throughout the structure and the stain was clear, allowing for the natural grain of the walnut to show through. The material was selected as it is seen as a regal, stately timber ideally suited for projects of this magnitude.

International Timber has now worked closely with EH Joinery for several years. A spokesperson said, "We have worked with International Timber for a number of years,

and they provide our hardwoods for bespoke stairs, windows and doors.

"The close relationship benefits both parties and allows for increased flexibility. We consistently receive prompt delivery, quotation and information on all products, which plays an important role in helping us to better serve our customers."

EH Joinery chooses to use International Timber due to the high quality of timber. The project was a total success and EH Joinery has said, "We will of course be working with International Timber again on a range of projects."



CASE STUDY TKSTAIRS



Laminated Redwood panels for TKStairs bespoke staircase

Specialising in made-to-measure, timber staircases ranging from simple straight flights to showstopping grand designs, TKStairs required two piece laminated Redwood panels for use as stringers.

The new panels were used to replace previously-used solid stringers. Due to the natural growth defects from the solid pieces, TKStairs had encountered increasing issues with the material. As a result, they were looking for an alternative product.

TKStairs and International Timber (IT) have worked closely together for some years. A spokesperson for TKStairs said: "We have a very good relationship with International Timber and benefit from their

real understanding of our business, offering sound advice and knowledge in all aspects of timber."

The project required two different sizes of timber, one 28x240mm and another 32x240mm. It was crucial that these sizes were exact, not just for reasons of quality and accuracy but also to avoid having to make costly changes to tooling systems. Thanks to IT, TKStairs now offer their customer a choice in stringer thickness, giving more control over their orders.

TKStairs now orders from IT on a weekly basis and is extremely pleased with the products and the level of service they receive. The company has expanded upon its offering, ordering stock in more varieties from IT based on service levels and product quality.



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
